

## Prime Speakers from EU-BR Cloud universe together at WCN and Cloudscape Brazil

Co-located with the annual conference of the Brazilian Computing Society (CSBC), 4-7 July, the <u>WCN</u> (6 July) and <u>Cloudscape Brazil</u> (7 July) events will host **high level representatives from government, industry, academia and researchers**, which will shine the spotlight on European (EU) & Brazilian (BR) excellence in cloud computing, big data & Internet of Things (IoT).

Both events will offer prime EU-Brazil forum to exchange fundamental advances in cloud computing, identify new research topics and help shape the future of cloud computing.

The <u>Agenda</u> was carefully planned, ensuring that high-level speakers are joining and several cloud computing topics are discussed, such as the future and challenges of both cloud computing collaborative and interdisciplinary research, EU-BR coordinated calls, open science cloud and much more.

## **Headline speakers**

Over 30 well-experienced and renowned professionals will be keynotes in both events, giving an overview from all sectors what is happening and what will be the future of cloud computing in Europe and Brazil.

Innovative start-ups are represented by Felipe Matos (Start-up Farmer and Brazilian Association of Start-ups) and members from cloud companies will join such as Carlos Eurico do Canto (Propus – Tecnologia alinhada a negocios) and representative from Usto.re.

Last but not least, representatives from **Academia** from **both Europe and Brazil** will join the panel.
